Item #1) Install a speed bump or traffic calming hump on Spruce Street, just east of Exchange Lane. This is being requested in order to calm traffic on this busy side street and improve safety for all, including local school children.

Item #2) To convert a NO PARKING zone on Spruce Street, south side, immediately west of Sackville Street into a parking zone, as parking is oversold in the area. The space in question has already been identified by Mr Gallippi, Supervisor, Traffic Operations, City of Toronto as a possible area to allow parking.

Item #3) To convert parking on the north side of Spruce from Parliament to Exchange Lane (along No Frills) from the current three hour limit to a one hour limit.
