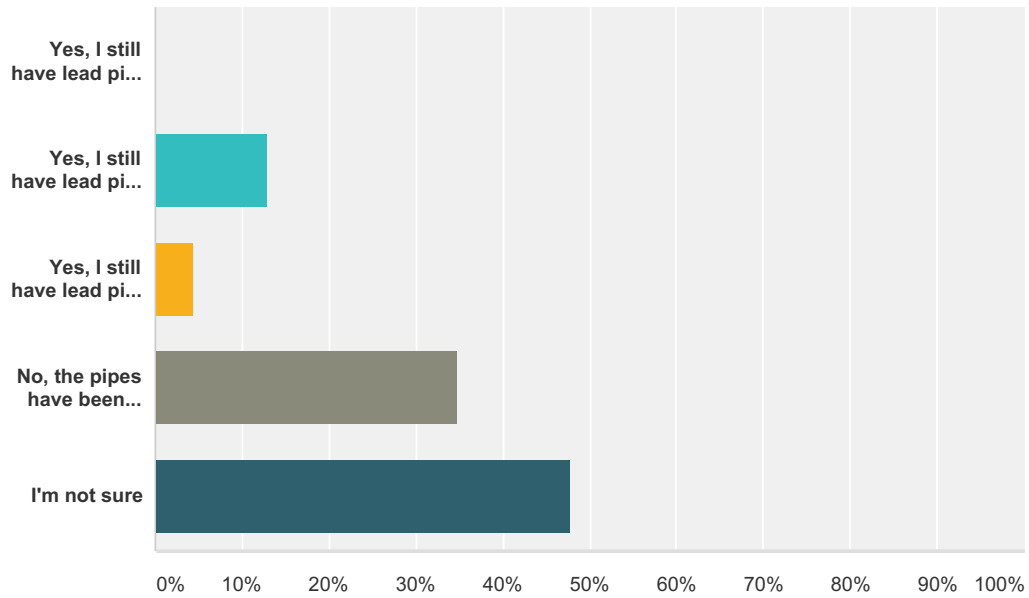


Lead Water Pipes

So yes, we still have a three foot section of lead pipe. P.S. There was quite a bit of incompetence the last time the water works people were on our street. It seems the city contracted out to some questionable contractors. Our water meter was replaced and the new meter was installed backwards. (Our meter reading went down as we used water). They had to come back and reinstall it. Then about a year later the supply pipe to the water meter fell out of the meter and flooded our basement. The plumber the city sent said the meter was not properly installed and should have been supported. (When it was originally installed the installer was asked if it should be attached to the wall and supported, he said it didn't need it.) While they were trying to turn the after off from the street, a few houses had faulty or worn out shutoff valves. (Salisbury Ave) The sidewalks had just been repaired and concrete replaced a few months prior. The water works guys had to rip up the sidewalk to access the pipe.
