NOTIFICATION OF FILMING **395 & 411 CARLTON ST**

Dear residents in vicinity of 395 & 411 Carlton St

May 17, 2017

T5 Condor Productions Inc. is currently filming the series "Condor", based on the 1975 feature film "Three Days of a Condor", which starred Robert Redford and Faye Dunaway. This series stars, Max Irons, Brendan Fraser, Mira Sorvino and William Hurt .

We are preparing to film interior and exterior scenes at **395 & 411 Carlton St on Friday May 26 from approx. 10 am to 2 am on Sat May 28. We will also film a couple of day scenes in the back alley, Gordon Sinclair Lane, of our actor running from 395 to 411 Carlton St. For our exterior night scenes on Carlton St we will have a lighting lift on the north side of Carlton St along the park with a generator for power. This will be for a light to provide a soft glow over the street and the park. We will begin prep on Tues May 23 and wrap out the locations by May 28 with minimal parking required only on Carlton St btwn Sumach St to Riverdale Park Rd. PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS LOCATION WILL BE USED A COUPLE OF MORE TIMES UP TO AUGUST 2017.**

We are planning to park our production vehicles in the following areas:

- South side of Carlton St from Bowman St to Sumach St. (May 23-25 - 8 am-6 pm each day and May 25 at 6 pm to Sat May 27 at 5 pm)**
- North and south side of Carlton St from Sumach St to Riverdale Park Rd (portions of this street for lighting lift, generator and filming between 395 and 411 Carlton St) (May 25 at 7 am to May 27 at 5 pm) We will leave any spots not required for permit parkers.**
- East side of Sumach St from Geneva Ave to the first three parking spaces north of Carlton St. (for generator and production vehicles on May 25- 7 am to May 27 at 10 am approx)**
- West side of Riverdale Park Rd from Carlton St to Geneva St for generator and smaller vehicles (May 26 – 7 am to May 27 at 10 am approx)**
- North side of Winchester St east of Sumach St for approx 6 parking spaces for overflow vehicles (May 26- 7am to May 27 – 8 am)**

Our main production vehicles will leave the area on Sat May 27 after 7 am.

PLEASE NOTE THAT WE HAVE MADE ARRANGEMENTS WITH Msgr Fraser College School at 55 Salisbury Ave for relocating permit parkers. It will be available from May 25 at 3 pm till Sat May 27 at 3 pm. There will be limited parking spaces and we will have 24-hour location representative watching all vehicles in the parking lot. Please see the back of this letter for map. Our location representative will give a pass for parking in the lot.

During our filming we will have intermittent traffic stoppages on Carlton St and Sumach St lasting no longer than three minutes at a time under supervision of Toronto Police Service.

Please note that we will have a representative from our production that will come by to obtain signatures regarding our filming after 11 pm in the area for the City of Toronto Film and Television Office.
