- And most importantly, we have a cake!




### What does the CRA do?







### **Process Improvements**

We continue to have a very close connection with Councillor McConnell's office through Kelly Sather who regularly attends our board meetings.

Kelley Teahen spearheaded digitization of all our documents and worked with Keith Lawrance to organize all our files in Google Drive.

Marc Simmons has moved our accounting system from Excel Spreadsheets to Wave, a free online accounting system.

- We were consulted on issues around Car2Go, AirBNB and Green Bins
- We advocated for and got closer monitoring of intersections with reported speeding / drive through
- We participated in TOCore consultations and represent the residents on the Main Street initiative, looking at a long-term plan for Parliament Street
- We represent the residents on consultations for the mural on the LCBO,
   Bike Share locations, and the future plans for Anniversary Park


