#### Year in Review

- Membership 827 total contacts, up from 778 in 2020, paid membership at 141 which is down from 194 in 2020
- Communications are conducted through a monthly newsletter, social media posts and some official CRA emails
  - Average of 450 email opens/issue 65% open rate on audience of 827 contacts (665 subscribers), well over the industry average which is 15 25% and a 25 30% click thru rate (industry average of 12.5%)
- Cabbagetown Poop Signs over 50 have been distributed to the residents of Cabbagetown, with
  more available. In addition to the two models introduced last year, one more was added for this

- 2021 2022 Completed Events included Holiday Light Contest, Holiday Card Contest, Annual Park Cleanup, Pumpkin Walk, 51<sup>st</sup> Forsythia Festival (signature event of CRA) – and celebrated back in person events
  - Congratulations and thank you to all who organized and participated
  - Food insecurity fundraiser raised a total of \$3,500
  - Thank you to our very generous local businesses who supported the Forsythia Festival and the 100 volunteers and organizers
